Concrete Steps to Creating a Safe Environment

April is Child Abuse Prevention Month. Each year thousands of employees and volunteers from our parishes, schools, and Catholic institutions in our Archdiocese attend mandatory safe environment sessions to learn how to prevent, detect, and respond to sexual abuse. At these sessions, participants learn how to become a "tell-able" adult through intentional efforts to create an environment of responsiveness so that children will feel free to disclose possible abuse of any kind. In such an environment, children clearly know that they will be heard and believed. Employees and volunteers are encouraged to display posters, pamphlets, and books that indicate a level of sensitivity to child abuse; to intentionally raise issues of "uncomfortable and confusing" touches with children; and to invite children to tell them anything that may be bothering or troubling them.
