***This project is in response to Parish Goals to encourage active participation by parishioners, become better stewards of our finances and reach out to our neighbors.*

Padding the church pews came from suggestions made in 2008 after the parish survey. A very small percentage of parishioners took part in the survey. From that survey, came our parish goals. Each month for five months a different goal hung in the church and we were all given an opportunity to comment. Even fewer comments were received once the goals were set in place. It is necessary to act on the voice of the people that voiced an opinion when given the opportunity.
