Catholic Charities' Migration & Refugee Services,

2911 S. 4th Street, a special resettlement service program for refugees through the Archdiocese of Louisville is having a "Back to School Drive" for the month of July and August. Particular school supply items that are needed for refugee children include back packs, rulers, erasers, glue, scissors, pencils, pens, colored pencils, markers, folders, notebooks, wide rule paper, and school uniform attire (navy blue and khaki pants along with white and blue colored dress shirts or polo shirts). In addition the following items are always needed: lamps, couches/sofa, kitchen tables with chairs, dressers/chest of drawers, full and twin size beds (frames, mattresses, and box springs) and numerous household goods (such as towels, washcloths, pillows, clock radios, lamps, twin/full bed sheet sets, mop buckets, laundry baskets, mops, brooms, dust pans, sponges, light bulbs, waste baskets, pots and pans, and various kitchen utensils).
